Rights and responsibilities of the patients

These include access to a doctor or health care professional within 48 hours. Patients should inform the practice if they are unable to attend an appointment. Violent patients will not be tolerated and after a formal warning will be removed from the practice list.

Dispensing

As a dispensing practice we are able to offer dispensing to patients living more than one mile from a pharmacy. We offer dispensing at both Churchfield and Sandsend surgeries. Please inform reception/dispensary of your preferred collection place. For patients living in Goathland there is a delivery service to the local shop - Please ask for details. Please speak to the receptionist if your prescription is urgent.

Written Prescriptions can be collected, sent to you by post (please supply a self addressed stamped envelope), or you can arrange with one of the local pharmacies for collection on your behalf.

Parking and disabled access

Parking and wheelchair access at Churchfield Surgery is available. There is a disabled person toilet off the waiting room. Please ask the staff for any help you may need. PLEASE NOTE that patients use the car park at their own risk. Disabled access, hearing loop and disabled toilet is available at Sandsend

GP Appointments

Appointments are pre-bookable either at reception on the telephone or on-line. Patients will be offered the next available appointment with the GP of choice. If no preference is given the next free appointment will be offered. Please inform the receptionist if an urgent appointment is required, special arrangements can be made to be seen on the same day if necessary.

Sleights and Sandsend Medical Practice

Nurse Practitioner

The Nurse Practitioner can diagnose and treat most minor illness. Infants under 1 year and pregnant women should be seen by a Doctor.

Practice Nurse

The practice nurses offer appointments Monday to Friday and hold the following clinics:

- Asthma
- COPD
- Diabetes
- Hypertension
- Chronic Heart Disease
- Sexual Health and Contraception
- Minor Surgery
- Wound management
- Travel - Advice and immunization, please enquire at least eight weeks before travel so that the necessary course of vaccination can be completed.

Please inform the receptionist of the clinic appointment you require so the appropriate length of appointment is booked. All appointments are pre-bookable at reception or on the telephone.

Healthcare Assistant

Our Health Care assistants provide a range of services to assist the doctors and the nurses including taking blood (venepuncture) Smoking Cessation, new patient health checks and a number of other health care investigations. Appointments available Monday to Friday.

Chaperone Policy

The practice policy is to offer a chaperone for all intimate examinations.

Sleights and Sandsend Medical Practice

Well Person Clinic

All patients have the right to request a general health check. It is recommended for newly registered patients, those aged 75 or over who have not had a routine check in the past year and adult patients under 75 who have not had a check in the past three years.

Telephone Advice/Appointments

If you feel you need to speak with the doctor but do not need to see a doctor you can request a **telephone appointment** - for example, for a test result or to discuss a medical certificate. The doctor would ring you at home at (or around) the appointment time. Please discuss with the receptionist if you're not sure if a telephone appointment is appropriate.

Home Visits

Wherever possible we prefer to see patient in the surgery but if a home visit is necessary requests should be made before 10.30am

Out of Hours

Between the hours of 6pm-8am a service exists for emergencies. An answering service will reply on the normal practice telephone numbers and put you in contact with an out of hours service. Alternatively contact NHS 111 on **111**. Further information and a symptom checker facility can be found at www.nhs.uk/nhsdirect

How to Register

On attending either surgery you will be given the necessary forms to complete. An appointment for a new patient health check with the Healthcare Assistant will be arranged

Education and Training

Medical students are occasionally attached to the practice. The receptionist will inform you if a student is present with the doctor. If you would prefer to be seen without a student present please advise the receptionist.
